The MEXTESOL Journal invites submissions for its 2010 special issue on “The Internet and Technology in EFL/ESL” from interested scholars and TESOL educators in Mexico and abroad.

Submissions are welcome on any topic related to the issue’s theme. In particular, we encourage original scholarly work related to classroom use of any of the following technologies:

- Internet, especially Web 2.0 and activities involving social media such as blogs, wikis, Virtual Language Environments, Twitter, etc.
- Handheld technology: multi-modal phones, digital cameras, i-pods, etc.
- Activities integrating technologies: digital storytelling, project-based learning, etc.

We welcome:

- case studies about the use of technology in EFL/ESL classrooms
- practical articles about the use of a specific technology or describing a particular activity involving technology (including case studies, if possible)
- theoretical articles about the effects of using technology in classrooms or about problems encountered when introducing technology to students, schools, etc.
- reports about pre-service and in-service education, including the development of Personal Learning Networks (PLNs)

Submissions should follow the standard MJ formatting guidelines (12-point Arial double-spaced, and wide margins with citations and references in APA or other standard format. The author will be consulted only if the editing has been substantial.*
